EDCON, the annual Explosive Disposal Conference of the Canadian Explosives Technicians Association (CETA), will be co-hosted this year with the Canadian Forces Counter IED Task Force.

This conference is of direct interest to military and police explosive ordnance disposal (EOD) technicians as well as those involved in EOD operations planning and leadership.

EDCON 2011 will be held this year from Wednesday May 11th to Friday May 13th. This conference is open to all police and military explosive technicians. We expect to have at least 150 attendees from across Canada and the U.S.A.
